LEGAL EMPOWERMENT FOR REFUGEES AND PEOPLE SEEKING PROTECTION

Following the success of the first Know Your Rights Programme ran by global business law firm DLA Piper, together with the Irish Refugee Council in January 2021, we will run our second virtual Know Your Rights Programme in Dublin starting on 2 September 2021.

Know Your Rights is a seven week legal education programme, delivered one day a week, for up to 50 refugees and people seeking protection who are building new lives in Ireland. This programme aims to support people in understanding their legal rights. It is also a great opportunity to meet new people and network with other refugees and asylum seekers to hear their stories and learn from their experiences. Know Your Rights is a DLA Piper programme run across the world.

We are delighted to announce an exciting opportunity for interested participants, who complete the KYR Programme to be considered for an internship by Deloitte.
